

To store or not to store (properly)...

That is the question.

1. The most important factor in proper storage of your machines is location. They should be stored in a dry, covered area like a solid shed or garage.
2. Visit us at Bainbridge Rental and purchase canned fuel:
 - TORO ALL SEASON for 4 stroke engines (mower, generator, etc.): \$8.99/QT
 - STIHL MOTO MIX for 2 stroke engines (chainsaws, hedgers, etc): \$8.99/QT
3. Run your machine out of the fuel that's in it.
4. Add enough *canned* fuel to start it and run it, about 1/4-1/2 tank.
5. Start the machine and let it run for 3-5 minutes. You want to get the fuel into the fuel lines and carburetor.
6. Start your machines once per month for optimal usability. And keep in mind that the longer a machine sits, the harder it will be to start.
